DOI SUTHEP & CHIANG MAI ANCIENT TEMPLES TOUR

Pick up from your hotel lobby and depart to **Wat Chedi Luang** (late 14th century), once the tallest monument in Chiang Mai and originally home to the Emerald Buddha, Thailand's most sacred religious relic.

Continue to **Wat Phra Singh** (1345), renowned for its stunning Lanna-style viharn (assembly hall) and the finest scripture repository in Northern Thailand.

Depart to **Wat Phra That Doi Suthep**, one of Northern Thailand's most sacred temples, built in 1383. Perched 1,050 meters above sea level, this sacred site features a magnificent golden chedi enshrining holy relics of Lord Buddha. Enjoy panoramic views of Chiang Mai City and the Ping Valley from the summit of Suthep Mountain. Ascend the 306-step Naga staircase, symbolizing the spiritual journey toward nirvana, or take a tram to the summit. Afterwards, return to your hotel.

Departure options: Morning 08:30–13:00 hrs. or Afternoon 13:00–17:30 hrs.
