CHIANG MAI OLD CITY & ANCIENT TEMPLES

Pick up from your hotel lobby and drive to the Old City. Begin at **Wat Chiang Man**, the oldest temple in Chiang Mai (founded in 1296) and once the residence of King Mengrai, the city's founder; it is known for its distinctive chedi supported by carved elephant sculptures.

Continue to **Wat Chedi Luang** (late 14th century), once the tallest monument in the city and former home of the Emerald Buddha, Thailand's most revered Buddha image.

Proceed to **Wat Phra Singh** (1345), renowned for its elegant Lanna-style viharn (assembly hall) and the finest scripture repository in Northern Thailand.

Conclude at **Wat Suan Dok** (1370), the royal cemetery of the Chiang Mai Royal Family, home to a gilded chedi enshrining relics of the Buddha and a celebrated Golden Buddha image cast in the 16th century. Afterwards, return to your hotel.
